Grep -i

Grep -i Stand for case insensitive. With grep -i you can extract lines that correspond to your search criteria no matter the case.

Let suppose a file name "name" that contain the name of many people , here is what it contain:

Dany Moore
Steve Hawkins
Roger Hipkiss
Loy Hinton
Mandy Moore
Candy Diaz
Fernando Diaz

If you do :
cat name | grep Moore

you will get :
Dany Moore
Mandy Moore

If you do :
cat name | grep -i moore

Or you can do :
grep -i moore name
And still get the same result!
