Grep -v Stand for inverse. With grep -v you can extract lines that correspond to the opposite of your search criteria.

Let suppose a file name "name" that contain the name of many people , here is what it contain:

Dany Moore
Steve Hawkins
Roger Hipkiss
Loy Hinton
Mandy Moore
Candy Diaz
Fernando Diaz

If you do :

```
cat name | grep -v moore
```

you will get :

Steve Hawkins
Roger Hipkiss
Loy Hinton
Candy Diaz
Fernando Diaz

Or you can do :

```
grep -v moore name
```

And still get the same result!
